3. What kind of attitude did Paul have in the face of danger (20:22-24)?
4. What does 20:35 mean?
5. Who is the "we" referred to in chapter 21? What does this imply?
6. What happened to Paul in the temple in chapter 21? Is he afraid to face and talk to the people, many who wanted him dead?
7. What is the content of Paul's message to the people. Notice how personal he makes his message. One of the best ways for us to share our faith is telling people what God has personally done in our lives.
8. What stops the soldiers from beating Paul toward the end of chapter 22?
9. When Paul addresses the crowd in chapter 23, why did a dispute break out?
10. In 23:11, what promise does God make to Paul?
